We have reviewed the report, "Mountain Valley Pipeline Project, Revised Management Summary, Work Plan and Schedule, Historic Property Treatment Plan Implementation, Underwood Farmstead (LE-0150)" that Tetra Tech prepared in June 2018 for the aforementioned undertaking. In accordance with the adopted project Programmatic Agreement (PA), and as required by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and its implementing regulations, U.S. 36 CFR § 800: "Protection of Historic Properties," we submit our comments.

The submitted report outlined the timeline Tetra Tech proposes to follow to complete the adopted treatment measures for the Underwood Farmstead (SHPO ID no. LE-0150), which will be adversely affected by the undertaking. We accept the proposed management summary in accordance with Stipulation IV.H of the project PA. We also concur with the proposed work plan and time table. We will provide additional comments upon receipt of *draft* proposals for the property's National Register boundary and period of significance, which we expect to receive by August 1, 2018.
