On October 13, 2017, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued an order granting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (“Mountain Valley”) for the Mountain Valley Pipeline Project in this docket. On October 31, 2017, Mountain Valley submitted its Implementation Plan for the Project. In this filing, Mountain Valley supplements its Implementation Plan.

This filing includes public information, privileged information, and Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (“CEII”). Mountain Valley requests that, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 388.112, the Commission treat the privileged information and CEII as non-public. Mountain Valley has marked the attachments as appropriate “CUI//PRIV – DO NOT RELEASE” or “CUI//CEII/PRIV - DO NOT RELEASE” or similar in accordance with the Commission’s April 14, 2017 guidance. Mountain Valley requests that the attachment labeled as CEII be restricted from public access and provided CEII treatment for at least the maximum period as set forth in 18 C.F.R § 388.113(e), and privileged treatment for the maximum period allowed for privileged information.
